

Pet Exportation from the Republic of Korea

- Pet owners should notify their personnel office of their intentions to ship their pet upon permanent change of station as soon as possible.

- IAW Korean Law requires dogs and cats departing Korea to have the following:
 - **Rabies Certificate.** Must be current and contain the animal's identifying microchip number. One year and three year vaccinations are accepted for travel. The vaccination must not expire while in transit.
 - **Health Certificate.** Form DD 2209 or an equivalent must be issued within 10 days of arrival at destination.
 - **Korean Export Certificate.**
 - Must be obtained from the Korean Animal Quarantine (QIA) office at either Incheon Airport or Pyeongtaek Port
 - Certificate must be obtained at least 3 hours prior to departure time and no more than 10 days prior to departure. A health certificate is required in order to obtain the export certificate
 - What to bring to the QIA office:
 - Animal
 - Traveler's passport or DOD ID
 - E-ticket or flight itinerary
 - Rabies certificate
 - Health certificate
 - 10,000 KRW per animal

- Animal quarantine offices

 - If using a GPS, 'Marine Center' will direct you to the QIA office
 - Driving directions
 - Exit the ROKAF gate

- Take an immediate right
 - Take an immediate left
 - Take a right turn at the second sign then, drive approximately 700 meters.
 - Take a right turn toward Godoeok RD/port (7/11 is on the right) this is the 302, travel about 2 kilometers.
 - Make a left turn on road 13 then, follow the signs for the port
 - Turn right on Road 38 then drive 10 miles until 38 ends at the International Ferry Terminal
 - Turn left to the entrance for public parking
 - The building is labeled 'Marine Center' go to the 4th floor then left out of the elevator. The door will be perpendicular to the elevator lobby.

- **Notice:** animals traveling to areas other than the mainland United States such as Hawaii, Guam, Japan, and Europe should contact the Veterinary Treatment Facility (VTF) to ensure that animals meet the specific requirements for entry into these areas.

 - Copy of rabies certificate
 - Copy of health certificate
 - Copy of flight itinerary
 - Feeding schedule if feeding in transit is required
 - Copy of Korean export certificate
